Does NOT refer to a religion Does NOT refer to a "race" "Ethno-linguistic category" An Arab is one who "speaks Arabic as a home language" Refers to a culture, though there is not one monolithic Arab culture






Jalam: one religion, two sects

 Disagree on the proper historical development of Islamic leadership.





Arabs in America

- ~ 3 million in U.S.
 500,000 in California
- Detroit area (incl. Dearborn) largest Arab-American community
 - 300,000+ with ethnic origins in Lebanon, Syria, Egypt, Palestine, Iraq & Yemen.
- San Francisco 30,000+ largely Palestinian
- Arab Americans tend to be highly educated: those w/ Master's degrees or higher is twice the U.S. average

60% work as executives, professionals, salespeople, administrative support & career jobs.
